Delegates' Council Report

Chair, FAAS Delegates' Council



Since my November Delegates Council e-mail (and its publication in the FAAS Report), several things have happened. First, I received (as I assume all Delegates did) a letter from John Peterson Publication Chairman, the FAAS Publications Awards Chairman, giving us the new Publication Award rules. As recommended by the Delegates Council, Category 22, which was formerly “Best Article on Live Food,” has been renamed to “Best Article on Health/Nutrition” to broaden its scope. The Council also recommended renaming Category 23, “Best Collecting Article.” Instead, the Board voted to retain Category 23 as it was, but voted to add a new Category 25 (renumbering the balance of the categories accordingly). This new category is called “Best Traveling Aquarist Article,” and is in line with the Council’s recommendations. Finally, the Council recommended reinstating an award for “Author of the Year,” which has been done, essentially conforming to the Council’s recommendations.

Second, in my November e-mail report, I mentioned that the Council was discussing a FAAS Website award. All comments received by the Council were in favor of such an award. Originally, there seemed to be a question as to whether there should be one award or multiple awards (as is the case with the FAAS Publication Awards). Now, it appears that a consensus has been reached that there be multiple awards.

Rick Borstein (the FAAS webmaster, and Delegates Council representative from the Greater Chicago Cichlid Association) recommended several specific categories. Rick also mentioned that he wants to see “that whoever judges the awards is qualified. IMHO, this person should have done some web development and have some design experience, e.g., is the navigation structured logically, does the site work well, etc.”

Jerry Riegel (Greater Cincinnati Aquarium Society) responded that “I do not think you need to have web development experience or have some design experience to judge a web site. The ultimate end user is a fish person. Therefore a fish person should judge the site for

content, ease of use, & etc. If only a web developer can sense the value of a site, and not a fish person, it has little value to the general fish person community. The web site and its technology should help the general fish person. Jerry also feels that "the web site judges should be selected as the other FAAS judges are selected. The judging process should fall in line with the other FAAS awards."

To explain his original statement, Rick Borstein replied: "It is helpful when somebody knowledgeable does a review. For example, if I'm buying a car, I would like to read a review from somebody who has broad experience in the industry, has driven many cars, and can compare them. Also, someone who has put hours into producing a site deserves the chance to have their work evaluated by somebody who can appreciate that effort . . . because they understand how hard it is to do a good job."

Finally, John Peterson, the FAAS Publication Chairman, wrote: "I know I am not a delegate to FAAS, but as the Publication Chairman, I think that having awards for websites is a great idea, however, I think that a new committee should be setup and chaired by someone like Rick Borstein. I also feel that multiple awards are a good idea."

And, that's where we are today. I'd like to recommend to the Board, on behalf of the Delegates Council, that:

- FAAS create Website multiple awards, and that
- the FAAS webmaster chair a committee of FAAS delegates to develop Award categories, along with rules for entering member society websites, and for judging.

If I do not receive negative comments on this within two weeks after this e-mail is printed in the FAAS Report, I will forward the above recommendations to the Board. If I receive any negative comments, or any recommendations that differ considerably from the above, I will hold off making any recommendations until the Council has had an opportunity to discuss the objections and/or issues raised. This is being sent as an email to the FAAS Board and Delegates Council members listed below. If you want to comment, please do so by sending an email reply to "All." While you are free to comment in your society's publication, unless you send a reply to this email to the Council, the other delegates are deprived of the benefit of your thoughts while we are in the process of making up our minds.
